A. I believe you can also make puppets just using a 22)..... and a 23).....Is that right?

B. Yes, they are very useful, because they can be made so quickly, you can do them in a few minutes, really. You take

a matchbox first to prepare the head, just the cover of a matchbox, and you 24).....over the coloured label on the matchbox, and on that you can draw a 25)..... with felt-tipped 26)..... Now when you have done that, you want to put your puppet together, so you take your handkerchief and put it over your forefinger 27)..... your thumb and third finger and you anchor the whole thing down by putting the matchbox firmly in place on the forefinger, where the head would be. Then you arrange the handkerchief around so that the tips of your puppet's 28)are showing at the edge of the handkerchief and you can secure it at the bottom with an 29)round the 30)..... if you wish, and then you can use it for quite a while.
