Day 1. Florence



Arrival at Florence Airport in the morning.

Dinner and overnight stay in awesome medieval “Villa Orlando”, situated on the beautiful lake Massaciuccoli in the heart of Tuscany, an area boasting great natural beauty and an impressive historical heritage.
